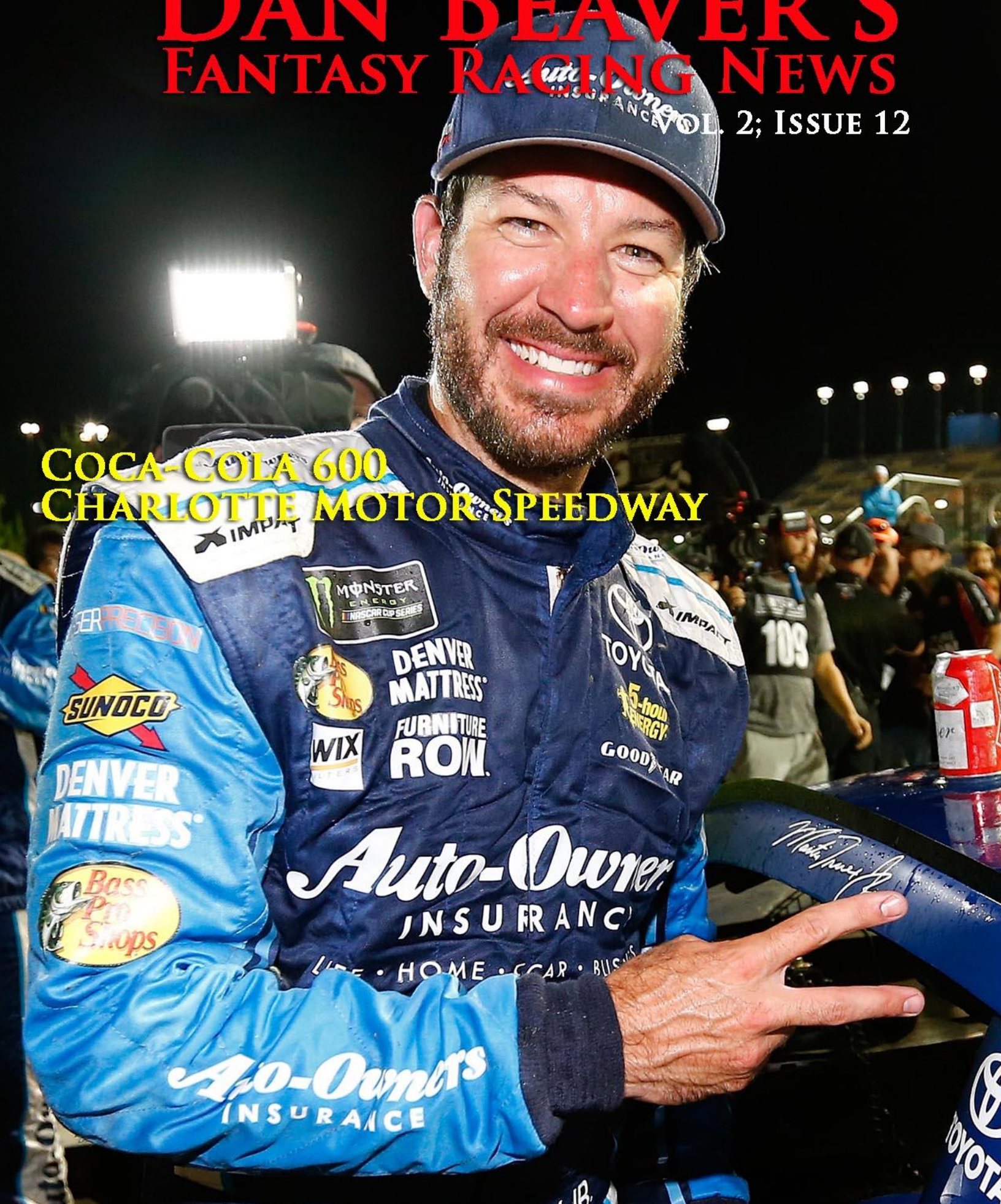

# Dan Beaver's Fantasy Racing News

## OVERVIEW

For the third consecutive week and the second time in a points' paying race, NASCAR visits one of the similarly-configured, 1.5-mile tracks.

Kansas Speedway and the GoBowling.com 400 turned out to be a pivotal event, but not in the way most expected. Accidents in the pits and on the

track collected Aric Almirola. Logano and Patrick climbed from their cars; Almirola dropped his window net to signal he was okay, but on further review, had to be cut from the cockpit.

In a season that has seen her enthusiasm wane progressively, Patrick was as dejected as ever before. Logano was visibly shaken by the impact taken by Al-

mirola in the race when either his crew chief or spotter cleared him too soon. This Young Gun has been mostly unflappable during the season-to-date, but even though McDowell was not at fault, Elliott rammed the back of his stocker after leaving the pits.

## MOMENTUM

Logano and Elliott momentarily lost momentum with their poor Kansas results, but they are solid enough racers to shake that off and get right back into the form that allowed them to be one of the

strongest fantasy options on similarly-configured, 1.5-mile tracks.

Entering the race, they were two of six drivers with a perfect sweep of the top 10 at Atlanta Motor Speedway, Las Vegas Motor Speedway, and Texas Motor Speedway. The significance of this is that—even though the politically correct television commentators bespeak otherwise—there is a huge “similarity” to the similarly-configured, 1.5-mile tracks.

Each track may race differently to the driver behind the wheel, but the requirements to go fast are the same. In order to excel on this track type, a team needs a racer willing to drive hard into the corners without fear, an exceptional engine program, perfect handling, and a crew chief who knows when to gamble. In other words, it takes the total package to run well on "cookie-cutter" tracks.

The other four drivers who entered the GoBowling.com 400 with a perfect record of top-10s were Brad Keselowski, Martin Truex Jr., Kyle Larson, and Jamie McMurray. There are no dark horses included in that list, unless one wants to add Clint Bowyer with a record of 11th or better finishes.

Ten races per year are contested on this track type and

those are events when fantasy owners want to play by the numbers. This is not a week to take wild risks on sleepers.

That is not to say that they should not look for ways to differentiate their roster. If one only takes favorites in pick ‘em games like Yahoo!’s or top loads in salary cap contests, the best one can hope for is to play to a draw. Pick your sleepers very carefully, however, and make certain you are comfortable with the marquee talent that heads the list.

takes on an erratic basis. Last year, Truex was the class of the field on several occasions before they either had a bad pit stop, penalty, or unfortunate circumstance on track.

One of the tracks on which they struggled was Kansas. Last week, most fantasy owners were probably waiting for something to go wrong. And in the closing laps, it appeared that Truex might not be able to get back to the front and would settle for a top-five. Determination added a few 10ths to his lap time and gave him the GoBowling.com 400 victory. It also gave him the top seed this week.

one can reasonably expect. He won the Folds of Honor Quik-Trip 500 at Atlanta, was fifth in the Kobalt 400 at Vegas, sixth in the O'Reilly Auto Parts 500 at Texas, and second last week in Kansas. There is very little reason for fantasy owners to find fault in that record and the only thing that keeps him from being a prohibitive favorite on one's roster is that he is absolutely not going to fly under anyone's radar.

Keselowski will be extremely popular this week and should only be used if one thinks he can earn another top-five.

Even though everyone knew it

was unlikely Larson would finish second in a fourth consecutive race on the similarly-configured, 1.5-mile tracks, it still had to come as a bit of a surprise to see him barely miss the top five. As with Keselowski, finding fault with his record amounts to nothing more than quibbling—but quibble we will for a moment.

Larson's overall performance has been so much improved in 2017 that one cannot but question how long it will last. Occasionally a switch flips in a driver's head and they accumulate streaks like the one Larson is riding—but it is not sustainable forever. At some point, Larson is going to have a bad race on the similarly-configured, 1.5-mile tracks and Charlotte has not been uniformly kind to him.

However, we are willing to bet that his struggles will not occur this week and that a top-five is in the cards.

the establishment, but he has served notice recently that he is not going to go gently into that good night. Harvick is going to rail against the dying of the light—even if he has to ride the uncomfortable rail (or cushion) to do so.

His determination is a big part of why he has earned top-fives in the last four consecutive unrestricted events. Stewart-Haas Racing has not gotten off to a great start, but what they have lacked in domination has been made up for with consistency.

Harvick should easily challenge for another low single-digit result this week.

This has not been a good track for Blaney in the past. In his inaugural race as a pre-rookie in 2015, he finished 42nd. That fall, he rebounded to finish 14th but could not carry the momentum forward. He was 20th and 31st in two attempts last year. His two worst results were occasioned by an engine failure in 2015 and crash damage last fall, and the two top-20s would not seem quite as menacing without the pair of sub-30ths.

Moreover, Blaney is a much-improved driver in 2017. He showed last week at Kansas that he has the ability to put a complete race together when neither he nor the crew makes a mistake. Being perfect for 600 miles is not an easy task, but the length of the race can actually play into their favor if something happens early.

Bowyer has come up two positions shy of sweeping the top 10 on similarly-configured, 1.5-mile tracks. He finished 11th in Atlanta and again at Texas. His other two results on this course type were a 10th in Vegas and ninth last week at Kansas. Not much was expected of this team at the start of the season, howev-



mately led to the failure. If not for the fiery crash and injury to a fellow competitor, he would easily be able to shrug that off; now, it is not as simple.

Still, this is what drivers do for a living and fantasy owners cannot expect that Logano will suffer the effects of the crash for long. He will quickly get back into his rhythm and should immediately get back into contention for a top-five. Before his accident in the GoBowling.com 400, he was riding a five-race streak of re-

aces on similarly-configured, 1.5-mile tracks this year, he has finished in a narrow band of seventh through 10th. Another result in that range—or even in the low-teens—will make him well worth starting unless a player is running short of allocations in the Yahoo! game.

## DAILY FANTASY MOCK DRAFT

Charlotte is the fifth cookie-cutter of the season, so by this point we have a pretty clear picture of who will run up front and who to avoid. Having these current season stats helps owners see the value in rookies such as Ty Dillon and Eric Jones. Four drivers also have swept the top 10 at the track type this season.

### Spurge:

#### Brad Keselowski

**Fantasy Power Average: 8.71**

Keselowski is one of four drivers that have swept the top-10 on the four “cookie-cutters” visited so far this season. He also has top-10s in his last four starts at Charlotte Motor Speedway. In these last four starts he’s only recorded laps led once in the Spring 2015 race. However, leading laps in that race was the end of a seven-race streak of leading laps at Charlotte. In his last four starts at the track he has an average place differential rating of +4.

#### Martin Truex Jr.

**Fantasy Power Average: 9.85**

Truex has five top-15 finishes at Charlotte, with three of those being top-10s. Truex won this race last spring by dominating and leading 392 of 400 laps. This season he’s finished in the top-10 at each cookie-cutter track, winning at both Kansas last week and Vegas earlier in the season. In his last four starts at Charlotte he has advanced an average of 2.75 places, only falling behind his qualification spot last fall when he finished 13th.

#### Kyle Larson

**Fantasy Power Average: 17.96**

Larson finished in the top 15 in both of last year’s Charlotte races, recording his best finish at the track last fall when he crossed the checkers in fifth. Larson matches the above two drivers in cookie-cutter top-10s this season and has finished no worse than sixth on this track type in 2017. If you look at his last three starts at Charlotte he has advanced an average of 13.67 positions, Larson has become a better qualifier this year and

er, so his 11th in the QuikTrip 500 made him a great value.

With solid runs all season, much more is expected now. But Bowyer’s value in salary cap games continues to reflect that little bit of uncertainty with Stewart-Haas Racing. Teammate Harvick finally seems to be coming into his own. Kurt Busch is legendarily erratic and Patrick is constantly on the verge of screaming in frustration. Bowyer has been one of their shining lights and so far has been able to avoid the distractions.

### Steal:

#### **Jamie McMurray**

**Fantasy Power Average: 17.48**

McMurray won his first Cup race at Charlotte in his 2002 rookie season. He has since won once more in 2010 and has had 11 top-10 finishes in his 29 starts. In his last four starts he has two top-15 finishes including a top-10 last fall. McMurray is the surprising fourth to join Larson, Truex, and Keselowski in sweeping cookie-cutter top 10s this season. He's advanced an average of 7.75 places in his last four starts and is on a seven-race streak of finishing ahead of his qualifying position.

#### **Eric Jones**

**Fantasy Power Average: N/A**

Jones has two top-15's at cookie cutter tracks this season, which came at At-

lanta and Vegas. His next two attempts failed to get him in the top-20 with back-to-back 22nd-place finishes. If Jones can rebound from these finishes and mirror his performance earlier this season he'll rack up some points. Jones has moved forward an average of four positions in his last four cookie-cutter races.

#### **Ty Dillon**

**Fantasy Power Average: N/A**

Ty Dillon has two top-15's and three top-20 finishes in his four "cookie-cutter" starts this season. His best on the track type came last weekend at Kansas. It was also his second-best overall finish of the season after a 13th-place finish at Talladega. Dillon has four top-15 finishes so far this season and has only fallen outside of the top 20 in four races. The younger of the Dillon brothers has yet to reach the top 10 this season, but has had the opportunity to lead some laps and finish consistently well.

Like Johnson, Kenseth is seeded in the top 10 based on past merit. When Joe Gibbs Racing is on their A game, this is the type of track on which they dominate. A few

years back when he first joined them, Kenseth won every other similarly-configured, 1.5-mile track race for a while. Those days seem to be in the distant past, but no one thinks JGR will continue to struggle all season.

This is the type of track that suits Kenseth very well. It takes a driver who can adapt and think.

The same is true of the 600-mile distance and although the No. 20 will probably not spend much time at the front of the pack or score the most "fastest laps", he will contend for a top-10 in the closing circuits.

Periods like the one Elliott currently finds himself in re-

veal a lot about drivers' character. The start of the season was magical with a streak of eight consecutive top-15s. Elliott had a chance to win on several occasions including the similarly-configured Las Vegas and Atlanta Motor Speedways.

The tide turned at Richmond International Raceway, however. He slipped to 24th in the Toyota Owners 400 and then crashed out of the Geico 500 at Talladega SuperSpeedway near the end while running in third. Last week, he expected to rebound but a pit road accident ultimately dropped him 10 laps off the pace and gave him a 29th-place result.

He is good enough to challenge for a top-10, but until his luck turns around it is difficult to say when that will happen.

Dillon's two principle rivals in the Rookie of the Year battle may arguably be in better equipment, but one would not know that by his recent efforts. Dillon has been the top performing freshman in three of the last five races including once on a similarly-configured, 1.5-mile track. He finished 17th at Texas to Daniel Suarez's 19th and Erik Jones' 22nd. Last week, he scored his seventh result of 18th or better in 11 races this season and that is enough to make him attractive in Group C or at his salary cap level.

Last week in the All-star race, fantasy owners saw a side of Suarez they might not have known existed. When he was challenged by Elliott at the end of the final stage of the Open, it appeared to be just a matter of time before the second-year driver got around him. Elliott was faster. He nudged the No. 19 slightly and got the Toyota out of shape. Suarez not only held onto the car, he kept his foot in the throttle and stayed in the lead until a caution waved.

Determination is not a factor that can be put into a handi-



capping formula, but it is one of the main ways a driver should be evaluated. In the GoBowling.com 400 at Kansas, Suarez earned his third top-10 of the season and Jones is the only other rookie with a single digit result.

Buescher is not the first driver who comes to mind most weeks. That can play into a fantasy owner's favor if he looks at not only the recent results of the No. 37, but also his record on similarly-configured, 1.5-mile tracks this year. Buescher has scored top-20s in his last three starts beginning with a 17th at Richmond and culminating in an 18th at Kansas.

That 18th-place finish at Kansas is also part of streak of progressive improvements on this track type with a 24th in Atlanta, 23rd at Vegas, and 21st at Texas. If he keeps getting slightly better results than the preceding one, he will challenge for a top-15 in the next few weeks and then might be ready to race among the top 10.

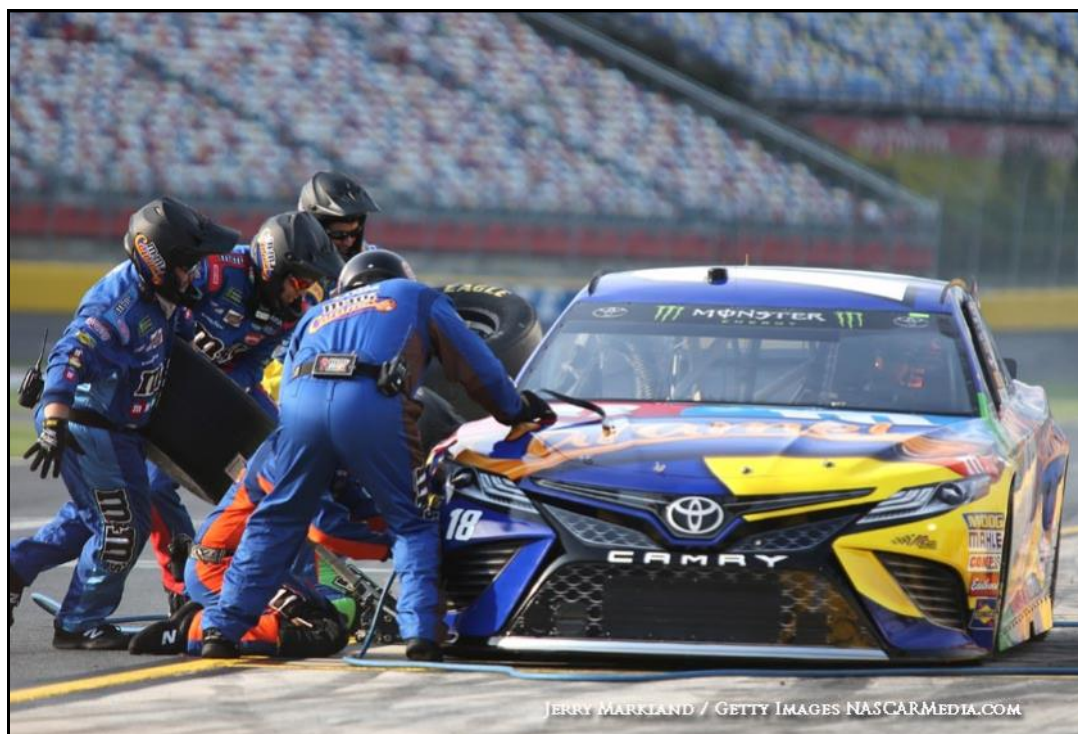
