OVERVIEW

NASCAR leaves one of its most unique tracks and heads to another. But while it is difficult to find a suitable comparative to Dover International Speedway, the same is not true of Pocono Raceway.

The triangular shape of Pocono certainly makes it one of NASCAR's oddest looking

drivers approach on entry.

There are two factors that allow drivers to race hard into the corners of a similarly-configured, 1.5- and two-mile track. One is the steeper banking used on those tracks than NASCAR's flat corners. But the other is the shape of the corners that allow racers to set and even change their groove once they are committed to the turn. At Pocono and

other car gets to their inside. There is not a lot of two abreast racing through the corners, but that does not mean there is not a lot of passing.

In order to overtake another driver, one has to back up to the previous corner. The most successful drivers on most courses are those who get the best run off the turn, but this is particularly true on flat



courses, but the length of the track and flat corners has a lot of similarities to the rectangular Indianapolis Motor Speedway.

Both tracks are out of NAS-CAR's norm in terms of their geometry and that fact is significant because it changes a

Indy, the line is determined on entry, not nearly as much time is spent in the corners compared to the rest of the track, and it is difficult to overcome a mistake.

Even if a driver does not make any mistakes, they can be put in a difficult situation if antracks. A car must enter easily and the driver must accelerate at the perfect spot at the apex.

DISRUPTED RHYTHM

In general, flat courses are considered part of the rhythm

tracks. Because drivers have to be precise on entry, one often describes a point in time when a switch goes off in the brain that allows them to find that perfect spot to roll out of the throttle.

This is truer on short tracks like Martinsville Speedway, Phoenix International Raceway, or New Hampshire Motor Speedway, however.

The long straightaways of Pocono and Indy add another factor to the equation and has made sweeping the track type more difficult.

Horsepower is critical even on the smallest tracks.

On the 2.5-milers, it is less about the top-end rpms and more about acceleration. The engine has to be ready to hit the maximum power curve at the exit of the corner and sustain those rpms for long periods.

Only three drivers swept the top 10 last year at Pocono. Joey Logano and Chase Elliott might have joined Brad Keselowski, Kevin Harvick, and Kurt Busch if they had not sustained crash damage in the August race.

That event was also shortened by rain, which may have shuffled the order somewhat, but the numbers were actually worse in 2015 with only two

Keselowski is the only driver to sweep the top five last year with a third in the spring and a second in the summer. Last year's Pennsylvania 400 would have been his instead of Chris Buescher's if rain had held off just a little longer. He also finished second in the 2015 summer race, which gives him three consecutive top-three finishes.

Coming off back-to-back races in which he crashed early, Keselowski needs to reestablish as one of the favorites. Bad luck cannot continue to plague him in every race and this is a good time to activate him while your competition is caught napping.

Based on many of the things we have said so far this season, readers might be very surprised to see Earnhardt in the top 10, let alone this high in the rankings. We stand by the assertion that he is not the same since the series of concussions and that loss of 10 percent—or whatever the true number is—will continue to make him a poor value in future events.

Pocono does not require the same attitude as the other unrestricted, intermediate speedways, however, and that could play into his favor. One has to hit the entrance of the corners hard and brake heavily, but the real key to success is patience and Junior has shown his skill with six top-fives (including two wins) in his last seven races on this track.

4. Jimmie Johnson

Hendrick Motorsports has long been one of the top organizations on this track with wins for practically every driver who has wheeled their cars. Johnson's latest of three wins came in 2013 and he has been a little uneven since then with two 30-something finishes and another pair of results in the teens in his last seven races. He has been strong in the remaining three, however, with a third two springs ago and sixth-place finishes in 2014 and 2015. He is second on the active winner's board behind Hamlin and tied with Kurt Busch.

5. Chase Elliott

Elliott stayed out of trouble last week at Dover and returned to the top of the order after several disappointing races. His fifth-place finish in the AAA 400 Drive for Autism was meaningful for two reasons: it kept a perfect streak of top-fives alive on that track and perhaps more importantly, it came as the result of his missing a last-lap accident in which he was right behind. His luck might be turning around

If fortune is once more shining on Elliott, he will challenge for wins again. In his first Pocono Cup attempt last year, he finished fourth and top-10s for rookies on this track are not all that easy to come by.

6. Kevin Harvick

As strong as he has been on most tracks, it is notable that Harvick does not have a Pocono win. With top fives in only a quarter of his races, he hasn't really come all that close on a consistent basis because this is a course that requires momentum to go fast. On the other hand, Harvick scored runner-up finishes in back-to-back races as recently as 2014-2015 and he finished fourth last summer on this triangular track.

Harvick also has recent momentum on his side with four top-fives and two more top-10s in his last seven races. The only time he failed to be a good value was at Talladega when he sustained damage in on one of the multi-car crashes.

7. Kyle Larson

Fantasy owners can take a little consolation in the fact that Larson knows his weaknesses. Prior to the AAA 400, he said he is not good on restarts and that is what caused him to lose that race. He can work on that and improve. Moreover, he still earned maximum

points in most fantasy games because of the number of laps led. NASCAR races often end in short runs, but that is not always the case and Larson can still be relevant.

At Pocono, his worst finish in six previous starts was a 12th and an average of better than ninth makes him a compelling pick.

8. Daniel Suarez

9. Jamie McMurray

McMurray is not likely to challenge for a top five this week. In 28 starts, he has never finished better than seventh. He should finish in the high single digits or low-teens again this week, however, because he has never finished worse than 12th at Pocono in the past five years.

Putting Logano on one's roster is going to require a leap of faith. He has sustained crash damage in three of his last four races and has not finished better than 21st in that span. He sustained damage last August as well and finished well down the order in 37th. In summer 2015. he finished 20th but he was lead-

ing the Windows 400 when he ran out of gas. Had he made it to the end of the event, that victory would have been his second on the track and part of a four-race streak of top-

fives.

The drivers picked for this week's DFS corner are picked solely on their past performance on the triangle trace.

Splurge

Dale Earnhardt Jr. Fantasy Power Rankings: 5.74

Everyone is holding their breath for Earnhardt's next win. Pocono is one of the chances for him to pull one out. In recent times, (his last 17 races), he's finished in the top 10 more than 50 percent of the time.

He had back-to-back wins in 2014 and two-top fives since then. In his last four races he has a place differential of +8.5 and has moved forward from his starting spot in his last seven starts.

Kyle Larson

Fantasy Power Rankings: 9.48

Larson has had top-10s in 50 percent of his starts at this unique track. Larson's best finish came in his first try at the track and his second-best came last fall when he finished sixth. With this year's momentum combined with his track stats he's primed for another great finish.

His place differential at the track is an impressive +9.25 in his last four races. The points' leader has also led in the last three Pocono races.

Kurt Busch

Fantasy Power Rankings: 8.03

Busch won this race last year after making the right gamble on fuel. In

Jones was one of the top performers early this season and it appeared he would be the rookie of the race more often than any of the other freshmen.

He couldn't quite close the deal on several occasions, however, and has scored just two top-10s in the first 13 races. Five of his other attempts landed in the top 15 and he has a 17th to go along with it. Jones has acquitted himself

well.

Last week, it appeared his would get a second consecutive top-10 on the heels of a solid Coke 600 run. He sustained heavy damage when Ty Dillon spun at the head of the field on a restart and finished 15th instead. This week, he should have more control over his destiny and could easily contend for a top-10.

14. Matt Kenseth

Kenseth is a strong enough driver to make the top 10 nearly any week, but Pocono has not been one of his better courses. Yes, he won the summer 2015 race, but that came as the result of a fuel mileage gamble and does not represent the remainder of his recent starts. That is his only top-five in the past decade on this track

his last 17 starts he's finished in the top 10 the majority of the time with 10 finishes.

He's advanced from his starting position in both runnings of the race last year, but before that had a bad record of high qualification spots and mid to low finishes. He's led 75 laps in the last five races with the majority occurring in last spring's win during which he led 32 laps.

Steal

Matt Kenseth Fantasy Power Rankings: 14.05

Kenseth won at the track back in 2015. He had four top-10s in last nine starts. In his last four starts he has a positive place differential of 1.75 and has led in three of his last five tries. While Kenseth has not been particularly strong on this track, his JGR teammates are and he should be able to crib from their notes.

Ryan Blaney Fantasy Power Rankings: 14.43

Blaney has only had top-15s at the track so far, finishing 10th last spring and 11th last fall. In both races he's advanced from his qualifying position for an average of 5.5 positions.

He has hit a long spate of bad luck, so starting him requires faith that he can avoid trouble in the Axalta 400.

Chris Buescher Fantasy Power Rankings: 18.71

Buescher won in one of his two starts. In general this is not enough to rate him on since that was a fuel mileage victory, but in last fall's win he advanced 21 positions. It was also his first win at the Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series level, lending itself a level of confidence that could make him a great deal in his new, more powerful ride. In his win he led 12 laps.

Equally notable, he struggled through five consecutive races outside the top 20 right after joining JGR and one would think that he would have picked up some good setup notes from his teammate Hamlin during that span.

This is Kenseth, however, and he deserves to at least be a sleeper.

With the exception of 2015, Newman has been perfectly in the top 15 at Pocono through his last two owners. He has completed all the Pocono laps in all but those same two races dating back to 2005 when he drove for Roger Penske. Consistency has long been one of his defining characteristics and that makes him a predictable value.

This is not a track on which it pays to gamble, so don't look for Richard Childress Racing to roll the dice on fuel, but they might still have a few tricks up their sleeve by shortpitting.

Petty Motorsports is not one of the mega-teams that command top-10s, but they have shown a lot of promise with Allmendinger and Aric Almirola behind the wheel. Wallace has a pure chance to show what he can do rather than having his accomplishments credited to the team.

The doubt surrounding him has to do with his level of aggression and just how anxious he will be to debut with a solid finish. Wallace is prone to overdriving and that could result in crash damage and a sub-30th-place result.

Busch is another driver who debuted at Pocono with a top-five. Instead of following that up with several more, he struggled throughout the rest of his tenure with Hendrick on this track and then got off to a slow start with Gibbs. In the early 2010's, he seemed to get the handle with a pole and three top-three finishes in four races. The last of these came in 2011 and he has not finished better than eighth since.

15. Martin Truex Jr.

There are two reasons to park

Truex this week: This is not one of his better tracks and he is going to be much more productive on another course.

Truex does have one win and two more third-place finishes at Pocono, but they are sporadic and surrounded by results outside the top 20. He won the pole for last summer's Pennsylvania 400, but sustained damage and finished 38th. That came on the heels of back-to-back 19ths.

Truex has the ability to dominate unrestricted, intermediate speedways and there are still plenty of those remaining on the schedule.

24. Ryan Blaney

All of Blaney's recent misfortune cannot be blamed on bad luck. Axles do not break on their own. Whether the team is trying something that isn't working or if the driver is getting too enthusiastic leaving the pits really doesn't matter much to fantasy owners who have earned minimal points. Blaney has also had his share of unfortunate events like accidents that were not his making, but he has tended to compound those problems by trying to overdrive or retaliate.

Pocono is a driver's track and that should have meant better than average results Bowver in the No. 15. It didn't. Last year, he failed to crack the top 15 in either race, which suggests this is a good time to give him the weekend off. The good news is that he has been running at the end of his last 17 consecutive starts on this track and has never failed to be running at the end in 22 career efforts. If there is substantial attrition, he could earn a top-10.


